Welcome back everyone. I hope you all enjoyed a good break over the half term holidays and are ready and raring to go for the second half of Spring term.


This week St. James class led a beautifully prepared class Mass to help us in marking the start of our Lenten season here in school.

During his homily, Fr Francis talked to the children about the importance of the three aspects of Lent: Prayer, Fasting and Alms giving. These three pillars of Lent help us to develop a closer relationship with God. As individuals we may choose to observe these pillars in different ways; possibly through making a Lenten promise to curb our chocolate or crisps habit (fasting) and use the monies saved to support others (almsgiving).

As a school community, we will also be marking these pillars through an increased focus on prayer (see page 2 for news of a parent prayer group running at school during the season of Lent) and through collecting for our chosen Lenten charity—the Catholic Children's Society. This week your child/children will have brought home a collections box. Please do encourage them to collect and donate perhaps a few pence of their pocket money or, even better, earn money for jobs around the house that they can add to their donation over the course of the coming week.



This will take place each Tuesday at 8:40am in St Cecilia's class-room.




Our Yr6 netball team competed today in the borough netball competition.


The team played really well showing great skills and teamwork across the court in all their matches.
